The aim of this Workshop is to increase innovation in biotechnology, to encourage young entrepreneurs to overcome difficulties encountered in the first steps of the establishment of new companies and also to promote public-private partnership.

MODULE 1 - STARTUPS

MODULE 2 - INCUBATORS

The session on Incubators will focus on presentations and interactive discussions in relation to key issues and challenges to build and manage BioIncubators as effective tools to promote effective technological innovation and establishment of biotech startups.

MODULE 3 - INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

The session on Intellectual Property will be aimed at providing the necessary technical and conceptual notions for Workshop attendees, considering Intellectual Property as a tool for protecting investments and technological developments and for adding value to business.
